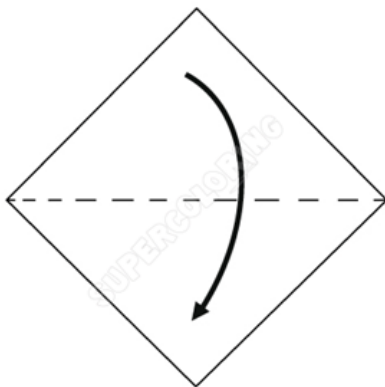
### Origami Tigers

#### 1. Easy Origami Tiger

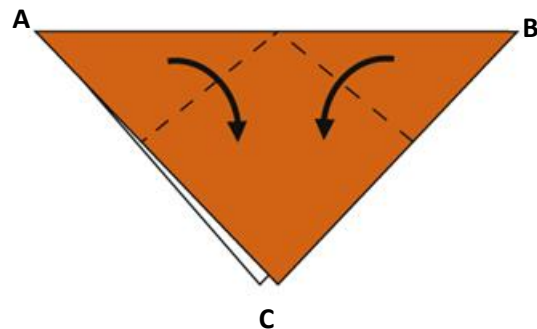

What you'll need: One square piece of paper, any size  
Orange & black crayons, markers or paints

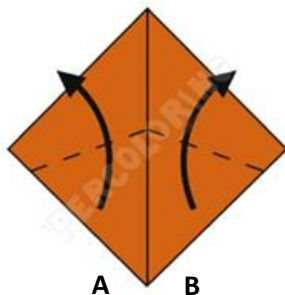
1. Fold the square piece in half along the diagonal



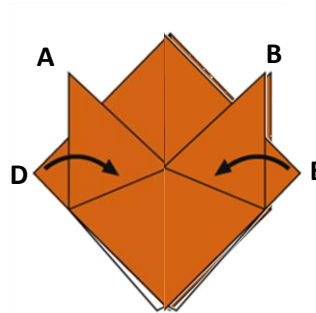
2. Fold corners A and B down to point C



3. Fold corners A and B up at an angle, as shown in the next picture



4. Fold small corners D and E over



(Note: You can either fold points A and B in to square them off, or leave them as in these instructions)

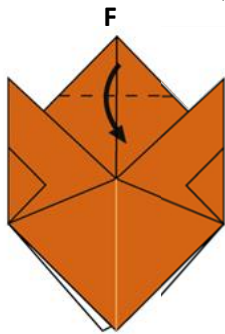

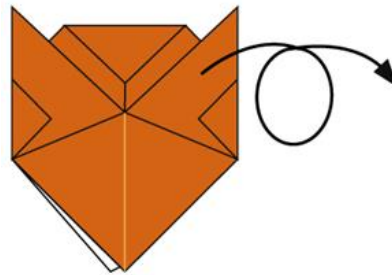

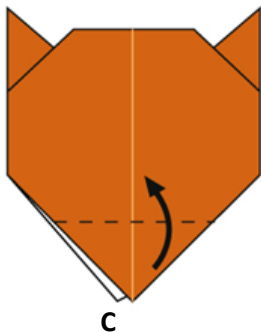
5. Fold the top point F down part of the way  
(as shown in the next picture)



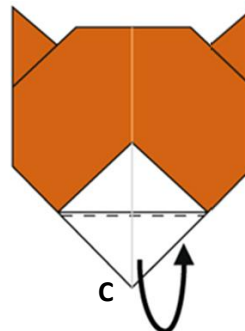
6. Flip the tiger over on to the other side



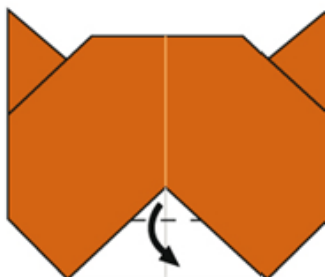
7. There are two flaps at the bottom point C.  
Fold the top flap only part of the way up.



8. Fold the bottom flap at point C back  
behind the tiger’s head



9. Fold the tip of flap C down part of the way



10. Decorate your Tiger!
